## INSTRUCTIONAL CONTENT COACH

### DEFINITION

Under the direction of the site principal, with support from Educational Services, the Instructional Content Coach Teachers on Special Assignment (TOSA), with release time from classroom duties, assist in the facilitation of on-going research supported best practices. These areas include curriculum, assessments, staff development, training and coaching for teachers with the goal of expanding proficiency, creating classroom instructional excellence, implementation of state content standards, and improving the overall performance of students while focusing on critical thinking and reflection from stakeholders. The overarching goal is to improve academic achievement of all students in alignment with the LCAP and site plans.

### EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Research and provide information and guidance regarding a range of effective and innovative content area-specific practices through various activities such as:

- individual and group discussions (informal and formal)
- individual and group coaching sessions
- demonstration lessons with pre- and post-discussion/analysis
- content area and instructional committee work
- staff/department meetings
- providing and/or delivering professional development programs
- delivering professional development to stakeholder groups
- successfully working collegially with teachers
- assisting and promoting in collegial development of teacher leaders
